**Subject:** Payment of Interest under Section 23(A) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 as amended.

Sir,

I am directed to say that you are aware that the validity of the land acquisition proceedings under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 as amended is for a period of three years w.e.f. that last of the four dates of the Notification under Section 4(1). It may also be reiterated that Section 23(1A) of the said Act provides that in addition to the market value of the land, in every case an amount calculated at the rate of 12% per annum on such market value for the period commencing from the date of the publication of the notification under Section 4 Sub Section(1) to the date of the award of the Collector or the date of taking possession of the land whichever is earlier is also to be awarded. As provided under the Act as mentioned above, the interest payable is generally estimated for a period of three years.

With a view to reduce the impact of the payment of interest, especially as 30% on the market value of the land is allowed and payable as provided under Section 23 Sub Section (2) of the Act, it is decided that henceforth the interest component in each case of acquisition is to be calculated/estimated (in form 5) for a period of 18(eighteen) months only. This would mean that it is to be ensured by all concerned especially at the office of the Collector to see that timely action is taken to finalise each and every land acquisition proceeding within that period.

In this regard it may also be mentioned that consequent upon the Amendment of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, in 1964, a suggested time frame for completion of land acquisition proceedings has been circulated to all concerned, copy enclosed herewith for reference and guidance. It is, however, noted that in some cases, the period for finalisation of a land acquisition proceedings take more time than what is actually required and is therefore uncalled for.

One of the means to speed up the proceedings is to put in place a monitoring system by which each and every stage of the proceedings under the Act is reflected in a statement, which format is appended herewith. I would therefore request you to see that the said format is utilised for each and every Land Acquisition case and care is taken to see that it is put into use immediately by the concerned staff. An officer of the rank of E.A.C. or above may also be entrusted with the duty of monitoring the progress of each case every week and corrective measures taken in time so as to ensure that the proceedings under the Act are completed and finalised within 1(one) year or at the most within a period of 18(eighteen) months from the date of issue of the Notification under Section 4.
